INSTALLATION TIPS

- Be sure to mount the control box on a post or piling in a well-ventilated area, ideally 6 feet above the waterline, and within 10 feet of your outlet.
- You will need to plug the system directly into a grounded 110V outlet. Using an extension cord, splitter, or plug-in timer is NOT recommended.
- Attach the weight to your wire an inch or two beneath the bulb with the included heavy-duty zip ties. Ideal depth is 5 to 8 feet below the surface at low tide.
- Once your control box is mounted and the weight has been attached to the wire, carefully lower the light into the water at your desired location, ideally 10 feet off your dock. Do not throw, toss, or pitch the lights into the water as this can potentially break the bulb upon impact.
- Once your light has been deployed, connect the photocell to the control box and wait for the sun to set!

OPERATIONAL MAINTENANCE

Under most circumstances, our Underwater Fish Lights do not need regular maintenance, however there are a few things that will ensure the integrity of your system. We suggest running the lights for a minimum of 8 hours to prevent marine growth. Additionally, it's critical that the lights remain fully submerged at all times and are never illuminated outside of the water as this will irreparably damage the bulbs. Lastly, please note that our bulbs cannot be unscrewed or removed as they are permanently sealed to the housing which is sealed to the wire. SEASONAL RESIDENTS


If you are a seasonal resident heading back north, we strongly suggest that you unplug your system, pull the light(s) from the water, unmount the control box, and store your Underwater Fish Light until you return. Not only will this prolong the operating life of your bulb, it will ensure that your system is kept safe and secure while you're not there, especially during hurricane season.

BULB LIFE EXPECTANCY



*There are many environmental variables that will affect the lifespan of your bulb, so please understand that these times are aproximate based on what we've measured over the years. Due to their colored filament, the Vibrant Green and Caribbean Blue bulbs have a significantly shorter lifespan and typically need to be replaced annually.

Damage to the wire can occur from fish hooks, oyster beds, rocky or abrasive seabeds, and occasionally marine life, specifically parrotfish and sheepshead.
